Education or possibly Social studies and Citizenship.

Seminar Description

In this seminar we would like to give teachers the opportunity to learn more and get inspired on how to incorporate the global goals for sustainable development in their lessons. The focus will be on target 4.7: By 2030, ensure that all learners acquire the knowledge and skills needed to promote sustainable development

We will facilitate the participants to start projects on the seminar theme, with an emphasis on collaborative activities among the students.

As this seminar will be held online, we will put strong emphasis on **interaction**, such as small group discussions, ice-breaking activities, polls etc.

As the online seminar will be slightly shorter than the IRL event would have been, the **pre-activities** in the **Twinspace will be more important** than usual. We would like most of the participants to have **found their project partner/s** before the seminar. We also plan to give a short **Twinning presentation (online) for beginners (8 October)** to make sure everyone is roughly on the same page the first day of the event.
